The Kids' Guernica exhibition

As to the Kids' Guernica exhibition, there shall be exhibited children's peace murals the size of Picasso's Guernica (7,8 x 3,5 m). One of these paintings has been done by children from Chios, Greece and from Izmir, Turkey to underline the theme of the Symposium focusing on dialogue between cultures.

Furthermore, under the guidance of Thomas Economacos a new peace mural shall be created during the Symposium. 40 children from the 108 Primary School of Athens shall paint a special mural to be presented to the participants of the Symposium on the second day.
